

PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AND SNAP ALLOTMENT ENDING...

MEDICAID

The Health First Colorado (Medicaid) Public Health Emergency (PHE) is ending May 11, 2023.

The Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) will take 12 months (14 months including noticing) to complete renewals for each of the approximately 1.7 million people currently enrolled.

Not all members will be renewed at the same time. Each member's renewal month will align with their already established annual renewal month.

What can members do to prepare for the end of the PHE?

- Update their contact info and communication preferences in PEAK
- Watch for and respond timely to official notices from the state
- Check the member renewal resources page at Health First Colorado: hfcgo.com/renewals

Coloradans who are not eligible for Health First Colorado or CHP+ can purchase health insurance through the state's official health insurance marketplace, Connect for Health Colorado:

- within 60 days of losing their health coverage
- or anytime during the open enrollment period

Coloradans who do not qualify for Health First Colorado or CHP+ may be able to get financial help to lower the cost of private health insurance through Connect for Health Colorado. The amount of financial help is based on the cost of the premiums where the applicant lives, how many people are in their household and their estimated yearly income.

SNAP

Colorado SNAP Emergency Allotment benefits ending.

All Coloradans who receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits are going to see a reduction in their monthly benefit amount after February.



The temporary additional benefit amounts (emergency allotments) are ending due to the result of recent federal congressional action. The last emergency allotment benefits will be delivered in February. You will still receive SNAP in March, but benefits will return to regular levels.

Here are some resources that may help you to obtain additional monthly food:

- TEFAP provides a monthly food package to eligible households and is available in every county in Colorado.

- CSFP provides a monthly food package to adults that are 60 years of age or older and meet income guidelines. CSFP is offered in every county in Colorado.

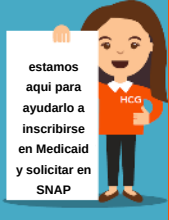

MEDICAID

El Health First Colorado (Medicaid) Public Health Emergency (PHE) finaliza el 11 de mayo del 2023.

El Departamento de Políticas y Financiamiento de la Atención Médica (HCPF, por sus siglas en inglés) tardará 12 meses (14 meses incluyendo el aviso) en completar las renovaciones para cada una de las aproximadamente 1.7 millones de personas actualmente inscritas. No todos los miembros serán renovados al mismo tiempo. El mes de renovación de cada miembro se alineará con su mes de renovación anual que ya está establecido.

¿Qué pueden hacer los miembros para prepararse para el final del PHE?

- Actualizar su información de contacto y preferencias de comunicación en PEAK
- Esté atento y responda lo más pronto posible a los avisos oficiales del estado

Los residentes de Colorado que no son elegibles para Health First Colorado o CHP pueden comprar un seguro de salud a través del mercado oficial de seguros de salud del estado, Connect for Health Colorado:

- dentro de los 60 días después de la pérdida de su cobertura de salud
- o en cualquier momento durante el período de inscripción abierta

Los residentes de Colorado que no califican para Health First Colorado o CHP pueden obtener ayuda financiera para reducir el costo del seguro médico privado a través de Connect for Health Colorado. La cantidad de ayuda financiera se basa en el costo de los premiums donde vive el solicitante, cuántas personas están en su hogar y su ingreso anual estimado.

Todos los residentes de Colorado que reciben beneficios del Programa de Asistencia Nutricional Suplementaria (SNAP) verán una reducción en el monto de su beneficio mensual después de febrero.



Las cantidades de beneficios adicionales temporales (asignaciones de emergencia) están terminando debido al resultado de la reciente acción federal del Congreso. Los últimos beneficios de asignación de emergencia se entregarán en febrero. Usted todavía recibirá SNAP en marzo, pero los beneficios volverán a los niveles regulares.
